

## **Work party items completed June 14<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>**

**On June 14<sup>th</sup> there were 13 participants and on June 18<sup>th</sup> there were 12 participants. Thank you for your time and talents. The following was completed.**

**Flag pole** – the new flag pole was installed

**Exterior of range** – the faded range signs (CSSA) were replaced on the north and west sides of the property

**Front gate area** – the fence post south of the gate was replaced and the wood from the dead tree that had been cut down was taken to the clubhouse to be stored in the brown shed to be used for firewood

**Driveway** – the pot holes were filled with gravel

**Garage** – the dead trees were cut down, cut into lengths for firewood and taken to the clubhouse and range 3 rifle/pistol, the building was cleaned up

**Clubhouse** - the gravel was spread around the building, new screens were installed on 2 of the doors, the safe was put in place, shelving was installed, plaques were placed on the walls and the office was partially cleaned, the switches were placed outside of the kitchen

**Range 1** – the hulls were bagged and taken to the landfill site

**Range 2** - sporting clay – the roofs were built and installed on the storage boxes, the hulls were taken to the landfill site

**Range 3** - rifle pistol – the stones were picked at action shooting, rubber mats were placed under the reactive target enclosure, the target frames on the 25/50/100 and shotgun patterning frame were repaired and new numbers installed, the wood was removed, one Big O drain box was installed on the north side of the 25 yard range and a pit dug and filled with large stones on the south side of the 25 yard range, the debris in the plastic barrels was burned

### **Work to be completed in the future includes;**

**Garage** – taking the freezer from the Sporting Clay range to the scrap yard (*Bill B is looking into this*)

**Range 1** – the awning needs to be repaired or a new roof is required (*Bill B is looking into this*)

**Range 2** – taking the wood cut up for firewood to the clubhouse, moving and spreading the wood chips – a front end loader would be useful, the debris in the plastic barrels needs to be burned

**Range 3** – taking the flood lights to the scrap yard (*Bill B is looking into this*), if flooding continues to occur, topsoil action shooting area and 25 yard (1 truck load could be spread ½ in each) rotten railroad ties need to be removed and placed behind the 100 yard berm - a front end loader would be useful, the building was cleaned up, 2 signs are required to identify the red/green flag system and which targets are approved/not approved (*Jay is looking in to this*)

**Clubhouse** – the office needs more cleanup, a sign is required to identify the water dial (*Jay is looking in to this*)

We need 2 new burn barrels. If you have access to them it would be appreciated if you could bring them and place them beside the flagpole for range 2.
